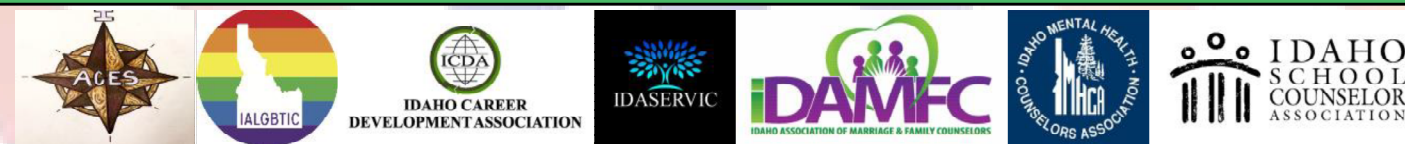

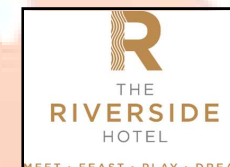


**Dr. Cirecie West-Olatunji**  
Dr. Cirecie A. West-Olatunji serves as associate professor at Xavier University of Louisiana and director of the Center for Traumatic Stress Research. She is a past president of the American Counseling Association (ACA) and the Association for Multicultural Counseling and Association (AMCD). Dr. West-Olatunji has initiated several

clinical research projects that focus on traumatic stress and systemic oppression. Dr. West-Olatunji has also coordinated disaster mental health outreach projects in post-Katrina New Orleans, Southern Africa, and Haiti.

## Dr. Joel Filmore

Dr. Filmore was recently chosen as the President-Elect of the national Association for LGBT Issues in Counseling (ALGBTIC) beginning in July 2016. He is also currently being considered for the position of President-Elect of the Illinois Counseling Association. He is an Assistant Professor with the Southern New Hampshire University, Clinical Director for the DeKalb County Youth Services Bureau, and Director of Clinical Services at Lighthouse Professional Counseling Center, where he is building a clinical practice treating families, couples, and individuals.
